


WeWork's rapid rise

A look at the co-working startup's funding history

WeWork has had quite the year. Since the beginning of 2017, the workspace provider has pulled in more than \$1B, bringing its total capital raised to around \$2.7 billion. The company's value has increased at a rapid rate since it was founded in 2010, from just under \$100 million in 2012 to \$5 billion in 2014 to more than \$10 billion in mid-2015. And now, just two years later, its valuation has doubled yet again. At this point, WeWork only trails Uber and Airbnb on the list of the most valuable US-based startups.



SoftBank has invested in WeWork in a round that could add up to \$3 billion and the startup has reportedly taken in another \$500 million to expand in Southeast Asia and Korea.
