



In Sept. 2016, a Malaysian retirement fund invested \$30M in the ridehailing company at an unknown valuation

^{*}This number represents a string of investments over 3 months, including \$100M from Toyota and \$3.5B from Saudi Arabia's public investment fund.

^{**}Chinese ridehailing company Didi Chuxing invested \$1B in Uber to buy out its operations in China.

^{***}SoftBank bought a stake in Uber through a tender offer completed in January that values the company at \$48 billion, though it also invested a reported \$1.2 billion at a \$70 billion valuation. All in all, the round values Uber at a reported \$54 billion.
